Executive Summary

- Prominent barriers for the unvaccinated: **perceived lack of long-term research/testing, and fear of side effects like blood clots and heart attacks/strokes**
- Family doctors, doctors in general, nurses and frontline staff are most trusted on vaccine information – **unvaccinated Manitobans have a particularly high level of distrust for the provincial government and public health officials like Dr. Roussin (74% 'not trustworthy')**
- Unvaccinated Manitobans place a disproportionate amount of trust on information provided by friends/family regarding vaccine information – our data suggests **many of them get information from non-mainstream healthcare professionals, researchers and scientists who are known for being critical of government/public health COVID mandates such as Dr. Joel Kentner**
- There is a strong correlation between vaccinated parents and vaccinated or will-be-vaccinated children

METHODOLOGY

Methodology

Study Population

- 460 Manitoba residents ages 18
 - A total of 362 were fully or partially vaccinated and a parent of a child under the age of 18
 - A total of 98 were unvaccinated with or without children under the age of 18

Data Collection

- A total of n=460 online surveys were conducted via Leger's online LEO panel.
- Interviews were conducted from September 9 to September 12, 2021

Statistical Analysis

As a non-probability online survey, a margin of error is technically not to be reported.

If the data were collected through a probability sample, the margin of error would be (n=460) $\pm 4.5\%$, 19 times out of 20.

The numbers presented have been rounded to the nearest whole number. However, raw values were used to calculate the sums presented and therefore may not correspond to the manual addition of these numbers.

DETAILED RESULTS: VACCINE HESITANCY

Unvaccinated Manitobans have a higher mistrust in public health officials and government in general



The data also suggests that higher educated Manitobans are more likely to have been vaccinated compared to less educated Manitobans. The same applies to higher income earners in comparison to lower income earners.

Only 3 in 10 unvaccinated Manitobans don't believe in any vaccine – almost 90% believe the COVID-19 vaccine was 'rushed'




Nearly half of unvaccinated Manitobans get most of their COVID virus/vaccine information from friends, family and third-party online sources


“Just reading news articles about people who got vaccinated and still get covid, makes you wonder if vaccines actually work”

“I look at how the government is trying to force people to give up their rights and freedoms. I also research independent websites that are not run in conjunction with government site. I also look at other countries research as well.”


The large majority of unvaccinated Manitobans oppose public health orders that restrict certain activities to Manitobans who are fully vaccinated

There is little evidence that suggests restricting the activities of unvaccinated Manitobans will lead to a significant increase in vaccinations.



There is a strong correlation between vaccinated parents and vaccinated or will-be-vaccinated children

Common themes among parents hesitant about vaccinating their children include fear of long-term side effects and their perceived lack of research and testing – *Actual verbatim*

Q11: Why are you opposed or hesitant about getting your children fully vaccinated should the opportunity arrive? Base: Parents who will not vaccinate their 5-11 year-old children when eligible [OPEN END] (n=28)

“Children show a higher immunity and lower rates of infection of Covid-19, vaccines may not be necessary for their age group at this time.”

“I’m not sure yet. When the time comes I might change my mind if I will or will not.”

“Again it’s not tested enough. I’m not putting that poison into my children’s body. Not knowing the outcomes of it scares me.”

“I JUST GOT MY SECOND SHOT YESTERDAY AND IN SO MUCH PAIN, HAVE CHILLS AND FEEL FEVERED”

“Same reason as why I do not plan to be vaccinated.”

“The same reason i said before , i believe natural immunity is better for young people then the vaccine itself”

“Higher risk to their health to get the vaccine than it is for them to get really sick from covid.”

“Fear possible long term affects”

“Because there was 2 shot now I hear 3. So the first 2 aren’t good enough there’s not enough research”

“I just don’t believe my children should be used as science experiments, or the fact that in order for them to live a normal life they HAVE to have this specific vaccine etc.”

“id love to chop you f***** r***** morons into one inch buy one inch cubes with a dull ax”

“The covid vaccine is too new and there is no long term data on what effects it has on the body. It’s one thing to get the vaccine myself but I don’t want to give my kid a vaccine that I find out 3 years later will ruin their life. I’m not against vaccines and my kid has all their routine vaccines and will get all the usual vaccines. They may get the covid vaccine in a couple years when there is long term data but I don’t know yet.”

“I wasn’t planning on getting the shots either because I was planning to leave my husband and immigrate to the US and needed it to cross the border.”


Common themes among parents hesitant about vaccinating their children, again, include fear of long-term side effects and their perceived lack of research and testing – *Actual verbatim*

She has had irregular cycles spin etc. for 5 months now since her first shot against my consent. Now she won't get this checked out because she's embarrassed, upset, & not trusting the medical system anymore.”
“Adverse side affects that have occurred in the family”	“Possible side-effects outweigh potential benefits. We are healthy and keep our immune systems healthy.”

Long-term side effects, perceived lack of research/testing are once again common themes –notably, some respondents claim they *do* trust vaccines, just not this one

“I believe here immunity is the best way for the body to develop antibodies against diseases. COVID to me is a scam and a money grab by government and vaccine manufacturers.”

“for children I believe the far effects are not so sure so that it's early for kids to take vaccine now we should wait a bit to have more experience”

“High breakthrough episodes are possible meaning you can still get it! & spread it even if your are vaccinated. This is not true vaccine like smallpox, measles, mumps, chickenpox, whooping cough, tetanus, what is that Will you get to disease, tuberculosis. They do have breakthrough but in such small quantities not like this COVID vaccine which are true vaccines. This is a money making grab & guinea pig testing on people which should be outlawed under the Nuremberg Act from experimentation on Jews by the Natzis. We are not guinea pigs. We don't know enough to accept these. They add adjuvants, preservatives, fetal cells are used. No we need to say stop, look, listen see studies. If people want to participate in medical testing then they should be compensated should anything happen not deniable plausibility.”

“Many things have gone wrong or caused serious damage or disabilities in children”

Mistrust in medical profession is somewhat rooted in the perception that ‘truth-tellers’ are being silenced

“They do what a pharmaceutical industry is telling them to do”

“too many doctors with dissenting opinions have been shut out of any discussion. this can only happen when people are hiding the truth.”

“My health has been consistently mismanaged by Doctors my entire life.”

“Broken bones, lifesaving surgery blood tests, & physical that's pretty much it.”


Parents of unvaccinated children are most comfortable with their primary health provider as a venue for vaccinations
