In COVID-19 Circular 2020-56 "Temporary Licensed Child Care Search Tool" (now called Manitoba Child Care Search), facilities were encouraged to access their account and update their information in order to help Manitoba families find immediate child care.

The process for updating your account is being simplified. Beginning December 14, 2020, you will begin receiving an automated weekly email from the Manitoba Child Care Search (MCCS) platform (www.manitoba.ca/childcaresearch). The email will provide a direct link to your facility's online profile where you are required to update your facility information, maximum space capacity and vacancies. This will ensure that families can view the most up-to-date information when searching for licensed child care facilities that meet their needs, and facilities will be able to quickly fill any vacancies that they may have. Successfully completing the update will eliminate the need for standard weekly emails and calls from your child care coordinator that request this same information.

In the attached appendix, you will find a short guide showing how to update your information after clicking on the link found in the email you receive.
