WILDLIFE SMART

ATTENTION CAMPERS

YOU'RE IN BEAR COUNTRY - BE WILDLIFE SMART!

Store ALL FOOD and OTHER ATTRACTANTS in a hard-sided vehicle/trailer/motor home (not in a tent or tent-trailer) when not in use, at night while you are sleeping or when your site is unattended for any length of time. Wildlife can be drawn to your camping or picnic site by odour or visual attractants.

Never leave ANY of these items (attractants) outside unattended:

- coolers
- food (open or sealed)
- garbage
- dishes/pots

- pet food/bowls
- bottles/cans/cups
- soap/toiletries
- items associated with food preparation

Do NOT feed wildlife in the park, including birds, squirrels, foxes, deer, etc. Feeding wildlife increases risks to human safety, people's property, wildlife health and the local ecosystem.

Once an animal gets used to being fed by people, or in areas associated with people, it can become a risk to public safety and may have to be destroyed.
