Table 3 shows the up to amounts that may be available to families caring for a loved one age 18-21 who is attending school and requires support and supervision during summer break. Summer Programming funding is based on the Day Services Funding Model.

Table 4 shows the up to amounts that may be available to families caring for a loved one age 18 to 21 who is attending school to cover school in-service dates throughout the school year. This service is intended to support caregiver employment where no caregiver is available to be at home with the individual and the individual is unable to be alone without support. In-service day up to amounts are calculated at \$19 per hour x 8 hours per day x 22 in-service days (including spring break and Christmas break).

Supports Budget Level 1, it is assumed that individuals have the ability to spend time on their own during school in-service days.

The expectation is that parents first use their vacation leave and natural supports (e.g. family members) to support summer and other school closure time. The service that CLDS is offering is based on these other options being explored/exhausted and is within their Supports to People Living with Family Supports Budget. In situations where the family requires additional supports in excess of their supports budget an exceptions review process is to be followed.
