Subject: Increase in the Laboratory Fee for Testing the Nitrate Content of Well Water

Effective August 1, 1989, the fee charged by the Manitoba Department of the Environment (Technical Services Lab) for testing the nitrate content of well water will be increased from \$5.00 to \$10.00 per sample.

As indicated previously in directive # 88-41, public health nurses will be advising social allowances recipients who require the test to pay this fee and then present the lab receipt to their financial worker for reimbursement as a health need.
