Ordering and receiving supplies from the provincial vaccine warehouse:

Large volume sites located in Winnipeg should order 1 month supply at a time. Maximum order is 3 month supply at a time. Newly registered sites are encouraged to place smaller orders (e.g. 10 kits) to avoid wastage while determining volumes.

MB Health staff may follow up with the sites prior to filling orders. Please keep contact information updated.

- Only approved Naloxone kit distribution sites are eligible to place orders.
- Emergency / after hours product service is not available for naloxone kits
- Naloxone kits should be stored at room temperature - between 15 and 30°C.
- Check the expiry of each kit before providing to clients. The product expiry is the last day of the listed month.
- Naloxone kits within 1 month of expiry should not be provided to clients. Please do not return expired kits to the Provincial Distribution Warehouse. Remove and discard the expired naloxone ampoules from the kit as per your facilities protocol. Repurpose the remaining supplies (e.g. for training)
- Delivery time is usually 3 business days in Winnipeg and 4 business days for rural sites from the date of order approval. Please order 2 to 3 weeks in advance if placing an unusually large order.
- Order cut off is 3pm daily, after which the order is considered submitted the next working day
- Please check your order on receipt to ensure you received the correct quantities and supplies in good condition. If you notice discrepancies, please call the provincial vaccine warehouse.

For rural delivery only:

- Facility must call when shipment received and let warehouse know if the monitor was flashing green (OK) or red (alert). If flashing red, product to be held until warehouse calls to release.
- Packaging and monitor must be returned to warehouse. A charge of \$150 may result if not returned.
