1b eskers and kames – predominantly sand, minor gravel

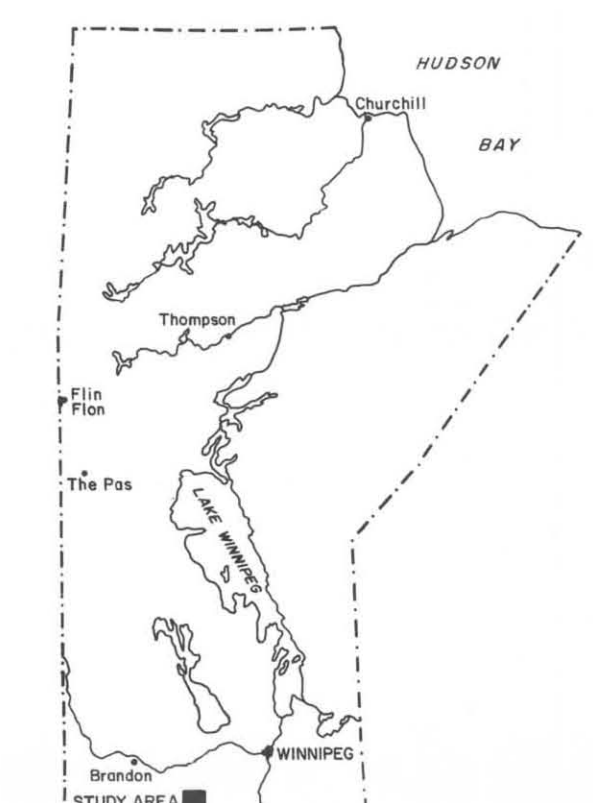
1a eskers and kames – untested, may contain sand and gravel
