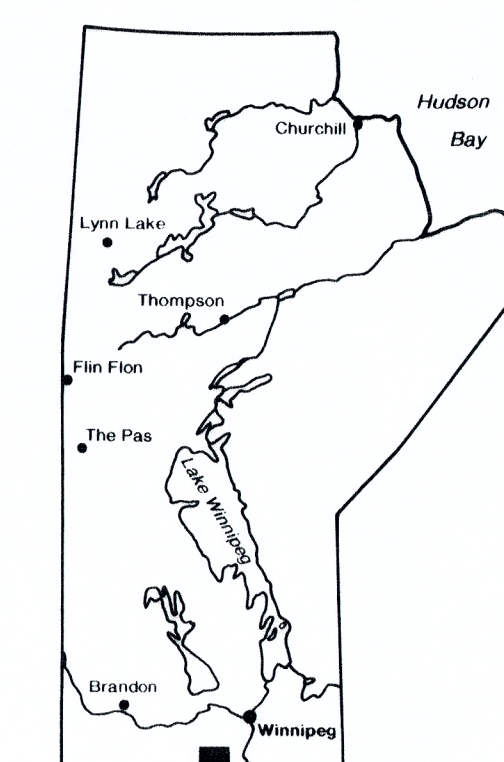
- 4 Esker:
