Regarding the list of consents for the above, it would be advisable to prepare a list, by Tracts, showing the acreage for which approval has been obtained. The Board will require (75) seventy-five percent of the head lessors' interest in the Unit area, under Section 77(b) of the Act, and they will base this on 75 percent of the acreage.

I believe there are 37 Tracts in the Unit, and the acreage to be unitized would be $37 \times 40 = 1,480$ acres. From your list, I would roughly interpret that consents for 1,225 acres or approximately 86.1 percent on an acreage basis has been received.

Also, I have interpreted the Royalty interest where shown opposite 1 Tract as applying to the 3 Tracts listed. (e.g., see Tracts 10-32, 15-32, 16-32 - with 3.125 shown opposite Tract 15-32) Should this interest apply to the 3 Tracts or only the 15-32 Tract? This makes a difference in the acreage approved.

I am enclosing a photostat copy of a list filed with the Board, relating to Royalty owners and interests in the Virden-Rosalea Unit No. 3. This is done on a Tract basis and it is much easier to add up and check. Possibly you could prepare something along the same line for filing with the original consents as it is possible the Board will check them off against each Tract.
