Chevron Standard Limited is currently in the process of converting from manually drafting production curves to having the curves plotted by computer. Until recently, we had been assured by the supplier that the special paper required would be available during February. We have now been advised that the paper will not be available before the middle of March. We are therefore proceeding with the manual drafting of production and injection curves for North Virden Scallion Unit No. 1 and Virden-Roselea Unit No. 1 where all the back history has been plotted. ✓

The preparation of the curves for Virden-Roselea Unit No. 2 differ from those in Virden-Roselea Unit No. 1 and North Virden Scallion Unit No. 1 in that all the back history for the latter two has previously been plotted whereas the back history for Virden-Roselea Unit No. 2 has not been plotted. The manual plotting of back history would be a very time consuming and costly project, the results of which would be of little value once the curves were adapted to the computer.

We hereby make application to defer the preparation of the production and injection curves for Virden-Roselea Unit No. 2 until after the special computer paper is available.

In our letter we enclosed a copy of a letter of April 11, 1966 from The Oil and Natural Gas Conservation Board of the Province of Manitoba in which they set out certain requirements prior to their making any unitization order. The first of these conditions was that the consent of the mineral owner, in respect to the Northeast Quarter of Section Five, Township Eleven, Range Twenty-five, West of the First Meridian to water injection in the offset wells(s) in the Northwest Quarter of this section, be obtained. According to our records Her Majesty the Queen in the Right of the Province of Manitoba is the Lessor of that part of these lands taken for a public road as shown on a Plan filed in the Brandon Land Titles Office as No. 217 and Chevron Standard Limited is the Lessee, the lease being dated February 26, 1965. Accordingly we have prepared the required Consent Form and enclose the same herewith and if this is satisfactory to you we would appreciate your arranging for the signing of same on behalf of the Province of Manitoba.

This will confirm my verbal advice that this Department would like you to prepare the legal briefs mentioned in your memo of April 1st, namely:

1. In respect to the fact that The Registry Act deals only with oil and natural gas, and ignores other minerals; and

2. In respect to the fact that in certain Land Titles Offices no registrations against certain parcels have been made. It is my belief that the records of the Lands Branch, of this Department, adequately show which lands and mineral rights were transferred from the Dominion to the Provincial Crown by the Natural Resources Transfer Agreement. However, this belief would have to be confirmed by Mr. F. B. Chalmers, Director of Lands.

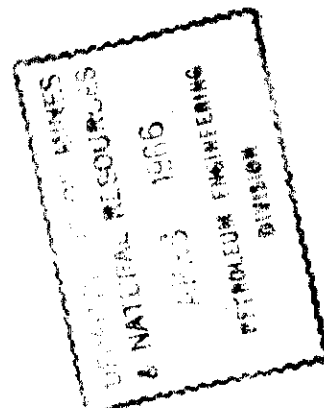

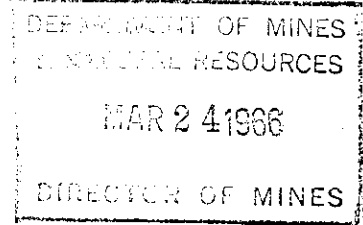

We have agreed that Mr. Moylan's travel and out of pocket expenses will be charged to the Mines Branch appropriation.

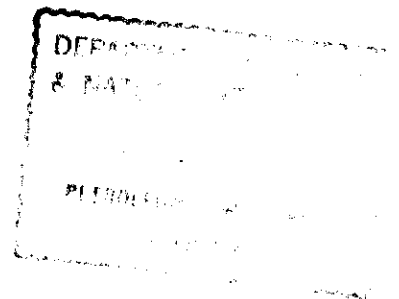

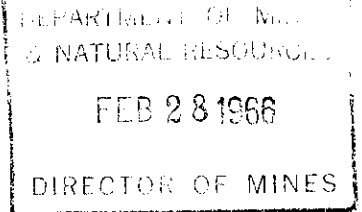


