THE LAW ENFORCEMENT REVIEW ACT (L.E.R.A.)

IN THE MATTER OF: T E. B Complaint No. 1740

I was assigned to hear the appeal of the above-noted Complainant. The appeal was scheduled for Wednesday, July 21, 1993, commencing at 9 a.m. in the 12th Floor Boardroom, 405 Broadway, Winnipeg, Manitoba.

Notice of the hearing of the appeal was sent to Mr. T. B , \times ADDRESS , Winnipeg, Manitoba, on July 6, 1993.

The hearing was convened at 9 a.m. and when it became apparent that Mr. B was not present, I dealt with another hearing where I heard submissions from the Complainant (in writing) and from Paul McKenna (orally).

At approximately 10:45 a.m. on July 21, 1993, at the conclusion of the other scheduled hearing, I called for the appearance of Mr. T. B. I noted that Mr. T. B. was not present. Both Constable C. C. and Constable G. C. were present in person and with counsel. As the burden of proof was on the Complainant T. E. B. to show that the Commissioner erred in declining to take further action on the complaint and as T. E.E. was not present to give submissions I determined that the Commissioner did not err in declining to take further action on the complaint. I therefore

dismissed the application of the Complainant, T E. B

Pursuant to Section 13(4.1) I ordered that no person shall cause the Respondents' names to be published in a newspaper or other periodical publication or broadcast on radio or television.
