# Gas and Oil Inspection Orders - Review and Appeal Process

ITS 21-030

#### **Review Process**

You have the right to request from the Chief Inspector (also known as the Director) of Inspection and Technical Services, a section of the Municipal Relations, to review the Inspection Orders issued to you by an Inspector if you do not agree with order(s) stated in the form.

#### Your request must include:

- 1. A written request submitted to the Director no later than 14 days after the order was given; and
- 2. The specific reason(s) for requesting a review of the order(s), and supporting justification.

In order to prevent delays in processing the request, your submission should also include:

- 1. A copy of the Inspection Orders form issued by the Inspector for review; and
- 2. Documentation to support your request for review (i.e. standards, manuals, engineer reports, etc.).

Upon completion of the review, you will receive a written notice from the Director regarding the decision, accompanied by the reason(s) thereof.
