**Manitoba Jobs**

An increase of 4,500 jobs (0.6%) from October to November 2025. Canada’s total jobs increased by 0.3%.

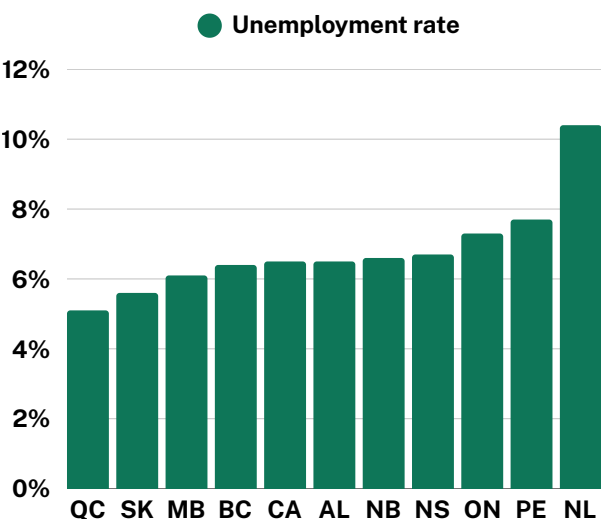
**Manitobans in the Labour Force**

An increase of 6,800 Manitobans (0.9%) from October to November 2025. Canadians in the labour force decreased by -0.1%.

**UNEMPLOYMENT RATE:**

6.1%

Manitoba's unemployment rate of 6.1% is third lowest among provinces, and also below Canada's average of 6.5%.



**PRIVATE-SECTOR  
EMPLOYMENT:**

+3,600

Private sector employment gained 3,600 jobs (0.7%) from October to November 2025.

**PUBLIC-SECTOR  
EMPLOYMENT:**

+900

Public sector employment gained 900 jobs (0.5%) from October to November 2025.

**FULL-TIME VS PART-TIME EMPLOYMENT**

+800 vs +3,800

Full-time employment increased by 800 positions (0.1%) from October 2025 to November 2025, while part-time employment increased by 3,800 positions (3.0%).



**AVERAGE HOURLY WAGE  
GROWTH**

+2.2%

Manitoba average hourly wages rose 2.2% (+\$0.68 to \$31.98) on a year-over-year basis, lower than Canada's 3.6% growth (+\$1.27 to \$37.00).
