Re: Municipality of Westlake-Gladstone - Biosolids Application - Environment Act Licence No. 3203 - Notice of Alteration Approval

Thank you for your notice of alteration dated January 22, 2025. The department understands you wish an extension of Environment Act Licence 3203 until 2027 to finalize Public Utilities Board and Municipal Board approvals prior to carrying out the work.

Clause 30 of Environment Act Licence 3203 was extended to March 30, 2026 on June 12, 2020 to allow for a 5-year phased program for biosolids removal and land application. The current request is for a further extension to the fall of 2027.

I approve the proposed extension of land application activities to the fall of 2027. Clauses 20 and 21 of Environment Act Licence No. 3023 contain restrictions that remain in place for three years from the date of biosolids application and must be reported in the annual report submitted per Clause 29 of the licence. Therefore, Clause 30 of Environment Act Licence No. 3203 is altered as follows:

30. The Licence shall terminate on December 31, 2030.

All other clauses of Environment Act Licence No. 3203 remain in effect. This approval is available on the public registry at https://www.gov.mb.ca/sd/eal/registries/index.html.
