A proposal has been filed by JR Cousin Consultants Ltd., on behalf of Manitoba Aboriginal and Northern Affairs, pursuant to *The Environment Act* for the expansion and operation of the existing Wabowden Wastewater Treatment Lagoon located on Plan 5712 Lot A in Section 20-68-8 WPM, at Wabowden, Manitoba to service the community of Wabowden, the CaNickel mining camp, the Setting Lake Wayside Park Campground, and the Ponton Motel. The proposed expansion will consist of construction of a new secondary cell, a perimeter ditch around the secondary cell and a perimeter fence around the entire lagoon.
