Agrium Bloom Terminal wishes to submit the attached Notice of Alteration for replacement of the stairs for the ammonia storage tank. The new stairs will have an increased rail height which will provide an increased level of safety to employees at the site. The new stair tower will be installed adjacent to the ammonia storage tank within the secondary containment area. Agrium is still evaluating foundation options for the stair tower, however, options being considered are shallow concrete pads or deeper foundation piles. It is our opinion that the project will not alter environmental effects related to the site. The project will not result in an increase in storage or operating capacity and will not result in the introduction of new chemicals to the site. We have attached an initial drawing of the proposed stair tower for your review.
