Located at Approximately 50<sup>°</sup> 22' 26"N x 095<sup>°</sup> 51' 33"W, Lac Du Bonnet, Winnipeg River, in the Province of Manitoba

Regarding the Notice and application (detailed above) to the Minister of Transport, submitted pursuant to the *Navigation Protection Act*, for an approval of the work per the attached plans, the Minister hereby approves the work pursuant to subsection 6(8) Approval after construction or placement begins, in accordance with the following terms and conditions:

- 1. A port hand (green) buoy with a green light shall be placed and maintained at the seaward end of the breakwater.
- 2. The green light shall have a minimum night time nominal range of 2 (two) nautical miles and display a characteristic of FL 4s. (as per the attached letter from CCG Marine Aids Program).
- 3. The crest elevation of the breakwater shall be maintained at 1 (one) meter above the Full Service Level 254.8 meters (as regulated by McArthur Generating Station for Lac Du Bonnet).
- 4. It is the proponent's responsibility to remove all portions of the breakwater from the limits of the waterway prior to abandoning the works.
- 5. Any proposed changes shall be reviewed and accepted by the Navigation Protection Program prior to implementation of the same.
