The new facility would consist of a two cell facultative lagoon with a clay liner in SE 25-7-17W, approximately 3 km southeast of Wawanesa. The facility would discharge twice annually between June 15 and October 31 to a natural waterway flowing to the Souris River. Construction of the facility is proposed to begin in the fall of 2014.
