This plan report describe the requested changes noted on the NoA.

Relocation of the Biomedical Waste Transfer Facility (storage cage).

• The interim storage facility (cage) is currently located inside another secured cage and has proven difficult to access from time to time. A request was made to move the interim storage cage approximately 10 metres from its current location. Doing so will provide easier access to the storage facility for warehouse staff who over see transfer operations. A map of the old location (yellow) and new location (green) is enclosed.

Name Change.

• Revise licensee name from Health Canada to Indigenous Services Canada (ISC). This is a name change only. Health Canada was granted a licence on 29 January 2015 for a biomedical waste transfer facility ("the facility") at 391 York Avenue, Winnipeg (in the warehouse located in the basement). First Nation Inuit Health Branch (FNIHB) of Health Canada is the manager of this transfer facility. On 1 April 2018, the federal government created a new department, ISC where FNIHB was relocated to and is now part of. There are no changes to the facility at 391 York Avenue other than the relocation request of the cage as stated in this report and the NoA and FNIHB remains the manager of this transfer facility.
