The Environmental Compliance and Enforcement Branch of Manitoba Sustainable Development has reviewed the above noted proposal and would like to provide the following comments:

1. The proposal does not provide any information on the operating procedures of the depot. Please describe in detail the following:
  - a. How used oil, filters, and containers are received at the facility;
  - b. Any training programs in place including acceptance, handling, storage, and spill response;
  - c. Record keeping procedures; and
  - d. Any other operating procedures that are currently in place.
2. Are there vehicle barricades or fencing in place to prevent vehicle collisions with the storage tank and drum storage area?
3. Is there signage present identifying the area as a used oil collection facility?
