## Dear Derek Peters:

An Environment Act Proposal was submitted to the Environmental Approvals Branch by BP and Sons Grain and Storage Inc. on September 19, 2018, for the development operating at 275 South Railway in Morden, Manitoba.

The proposal was advertised and underwent technical and public review. During the technical review, additional information was requested regarding the particulate emission mitigation strategies. Numerous extensions over the last five years have provided BP and Sons Grain Inc. with adequate opportunity to participate in the licensing process. On December 16, 2022, Kenneth Thomas, Corporate Controller for BP and Sons Grain Inc., confirmed that an engineer has not been sourced to complete the required assessments.

This letter is to formally confirm the proposal is considered withdrawn from the environmental assessment and licensing process, and your file is now closed.
