An Environment Act Proposal has been filed by A&I Products Canada Inc. for its Altona manufacturing facility for the continued operation of a metal combine parts fabrication facility at 432 Railway Street South (Lot 13 and 22 of Plan 509 MLTO (W Div) in SE ¼ 05-02-01 WPM) in Altona, Manitoba. The facility manufactures and supply various after-market parts used in many makes and models of combine equipment. The manufacturing process uses cutting, bending, punching, welding, assembly, and painting.
