Environment Act Licence no. 3401 – Notice of Alteration

I am writing to file a Notice of Alteration (NoA) to Environment Act Licence (EAL) no. 3401 for the construction and operation of a solar glass manufacturing facility in Selkirk, MB.

This NoA is to extend the expiry date of EAL 3401 from May 3rd, 2026, to May 3rd 2029. No other elements of EAL 3401 are requested to be altered.

Recent solar glass market conditions along with the threat of tariffs from the US (where our customers are based) have made it extremely difficult to raise the financing required for a project of this magnitude. We are, however, confident that the market will strengthen and that we will be in a position to commence construction before May 3rd 2029.

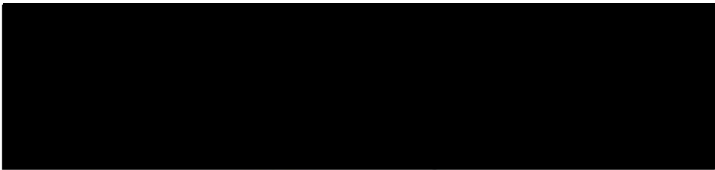
