Revocation of Designation under the Contaminated Sites Remediation Act

This letter is to advise you that the designation of the above-noted property (the site) as an impacted site, has been revoked under section 7.2(1) of The Contaminated Sites Remediation Act, C.C.S.M, c. C205.

Manitoba Conservation and Climate also acknowledges receipt of the report entitled "*287 Main Street, Selkirk, Manitoba, Closure Report*" prepared by AECOM Canada Ltd. dated April 6, 2021 for the above-noted property (the site).

Manitoba Conservation and Climate concurs that the report submitted adequately documents the remedial activities that have been carried out at the site are in accordance with the submitted and approved Remediation Plan.

It is the position of Manitoba Conservation and Climate that no further remediation is required on this site at this time. In the event that any residual contamination remaining on the site results in some form of exposure concern in the future, the responsible party will be directed by this department to initiate any remedial measures.

It should be noted that the position of Manitoba Conservation and Climate as stated in this letter is based on the information provided to this office by AECOM Canada Ltd. and relates only to the matters within the scope of the investigation that was conducted by AECOM Canada Ltd. No additional site monitoring was performed by Manitoba Sustainable Development.
