Subject: Preliminary Underground Storage Tank (UST) Investigation at the Sutherland Avenue Operations Facility

Decommissioning of the USTs at the Sutherland Facility will be completed as a component of the overall site management plan following Phase II investigations at the Facility. At the present time, the USTs have been placed in an inactive state and have been or are about to be pumped of any remaining liquids and sludges at the bottom of the three (3) USTs. It was indicated by Manitoba Environment that the generator number established for recycling of the waste oil would apply to liquids removed from the petroleum USTs.
